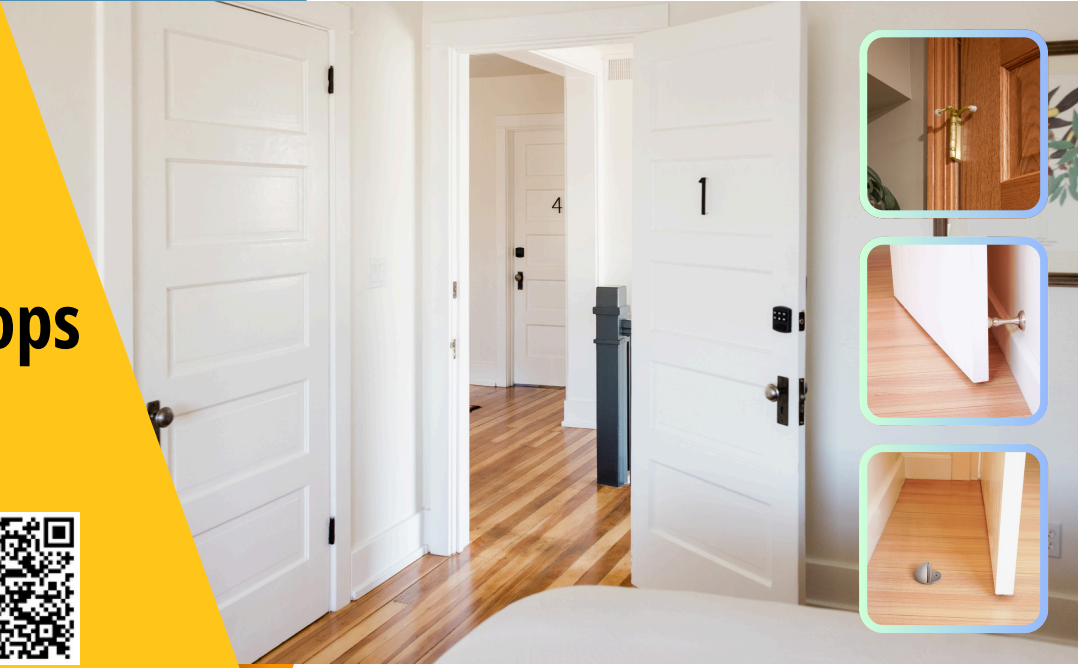


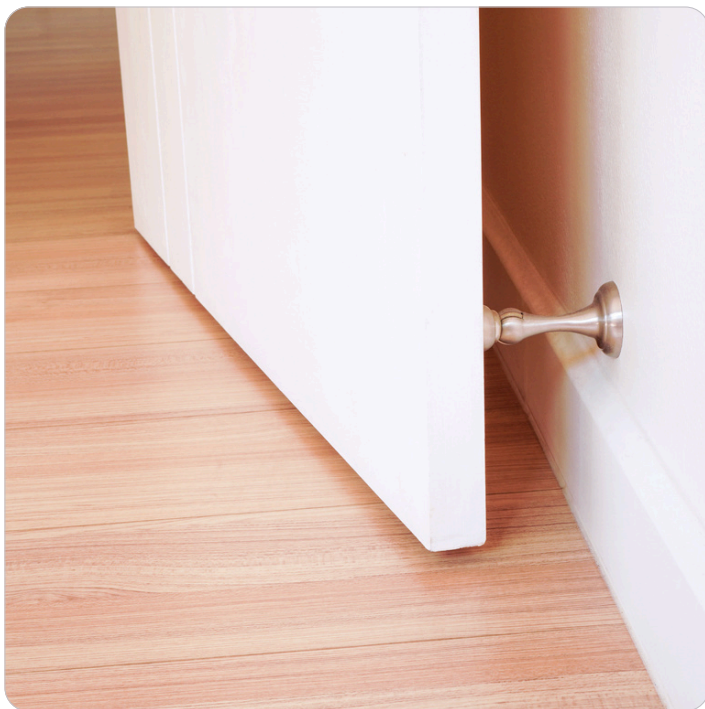

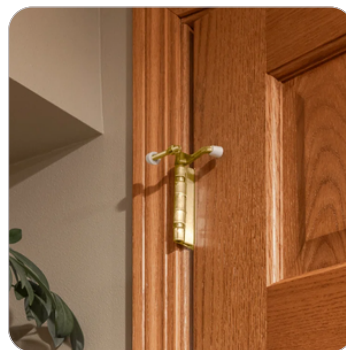

Soft-Catch Door Stop

Features

Hinge Pin

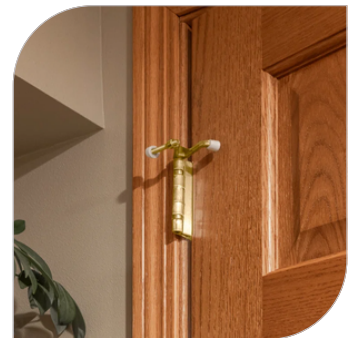
Hinge Pin Door Stop
